About Us

Cold-in-Place Asphalt Recycling is the process of removing damaged asphalt, reprocessing it, and placing it back on the road surface to be repaved. We have been recycling asphalt since 1991, and since then, have recycled over 16,000,000m² of roadways (approx. 2,100km of roads).

Work Location

Durham is the base of operations for our Cold-in-Place Asphalt Recycling Division, however, our crews move throughout the entire province of Ontario.

Working Hours / Lifestyle

Our Ontario Cold-in-Place crews regularly work 10 to 12 hours per day, 5 to 7 days per week. When work locations are remote (often), motel accommodations are provided, along with a meal allowance.
